## COMMON COTTONWOOD

Common Cottonwood is one of the greatest causes of allergy in the US. In Oklahoma and Colorado, for example, 20% of allergy symptoms can be attributed to Cottonwood trees.<sup>1</sup>

Common Cottonwood is prevalent from the northeast to the southeast United States extending into the Great Plains and north into Canada. Three related cottonwoods dominate the western United States. The dominating Cottonwoods in North America are Common *P. deltoides*, Black *P. trichocarpa*, and Arizona *P. fremontii*.

Common Cottonwood is cross-reactive with aspen, poplars, and other cottonwoods.

Johnson Grass (*Sorghum halepense*) is found throughout the United States along roads, railways and in abandoned areas. Sometimes Johnson Grass is planted for erosion control, reclamation projects, or forage for cattle. However, it can be toxic to cattle when the plant is stressed during drought or freezing conditions. Johnson Grass is cross-reactive with Sudan Grass and Common Sorghum.

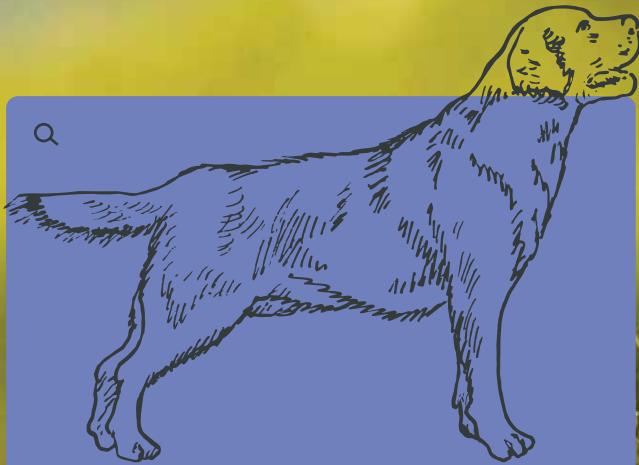

## FIRE ANTS

Fire ants are reddish-brown ants living in large mounds, mostly in warmer climates. They attack with little warning, inserting highly concentrated toxins that cause burning and pain. Fire ants are prevalent in the southern United States from Texas to North Carolina. Red fire ant is the most prevalent species, and based on research, the venom from the red and black species of fire ants appear to be highly cross-reactive.

Fire ants bite with their jaws while they sting. This allows them to pull the stinger out, rotate and sting again. A single ant can inflict several stings in a matter of moments. For people with fire ant allergy, stings may cause severe reactions, including anaphylaxis.

## VENOM ALLERGIES

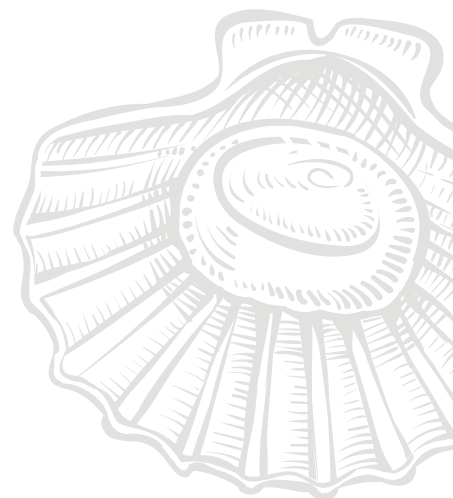

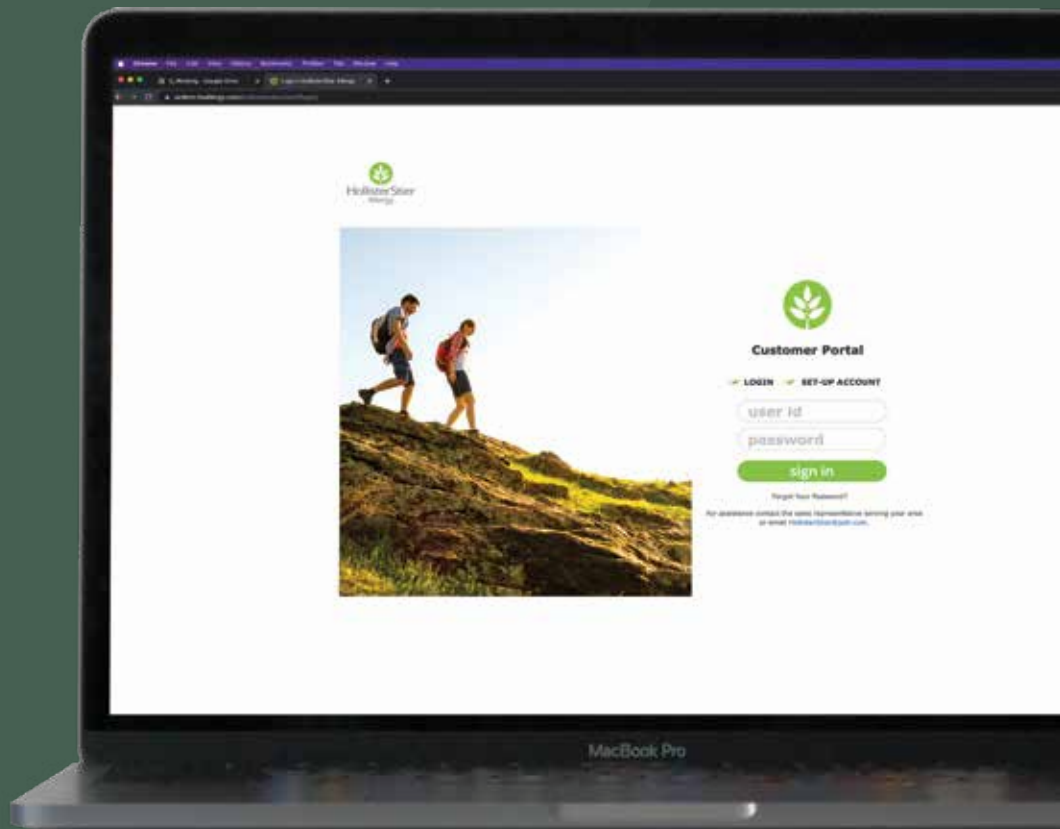
